“Guiding Principles”

- The Guiding Principles remain broadly defined to provide overview of a topic in lieu of a specific direction or solution.
- Guiding Principles by the Planning Committee are as follows (in prioritized order):
 - 1. The solution should provide flexibility to improve the educational environment and enhance curriculum and instructional delivery including updating the existing facility (code, electrical, HVAC, safety, and security).**
 - 2. The solution should create a more open, modern environment that promotes high student achievement and prepares students for their life choices beyond high school.**
 - 3. The solution should be aesthetically pleasing, create curb appeal and drive the District’s rich tradition of excellence to the forefront of local and community standards.**
 - 4. The solution should provide students access to a wide variety of technology.**
 - 5. The solution should improve the District’s ability to convert operational dollars into educational dollars.**
